

KENNEDY HEIGHTS COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Date: February 18, 2003 Opened: 07:30 PM. Adjourned: 09:18 PM. Attendance count was 54.

Joshua Swain, president, called the meeting to order.

Sheral Foster, secretary, read a summary of the January 21, 2003 minutes, which were accepted.

Bob Kamp's treasurer report for January was accepted. Account balance - \$10,975. Disbursements - \$736. Receipts - \$298.

Captain Bill Long reported that there were 69 responses in January. Captain Long provided pamphlets for the Shelter In Place advisory. Captain Long's Contact number is 513 357 7596.

The president bypassed committee reports to allow more time for the Comprehensive Planning Committee's presentation.

Ernie Barbeau, chair of the Comprehensive Planning Committee, led a presentation of the highlights of the plan along with members of his committee. Residents could submit questions or concerns to Ernie or Kay Briggs, coordinator. This information will be presented to the executive committee for review.

The president requested a vote to accept the proposal. There were 36 votes (show of hands) to accept the proposal and none against.

The proposal to amend the KH constitution was presented via flyer and will require action at the March meeting.

Applications for the Safe and Clean Neighborhood Fund will be available soon. David Pepper advised that he would advise KHCC.
