The meeting was called to order at 7:38 PM

- 1) October minutes approved. Motion: Steve, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Samara. Ayes: 100%, Nays: 0.
- 2) Public Safety (Off. Rice): report given on theft of auto (car recovered), breaking and entering, burglary (Zinsle), aggravated menacing (Northdale), domestic violence (with an arrest, Woodford), discharge of firearm (Ravenwood), credit card scam, phone harassment, theft of dog (Montgomery Rd.), theft from auto (Dune).
  - \*Question (Mary): regarding Shroder housing court. Off. Rice will reach out to Mark or Jackie regarding this.
- 3) Fire: Chief Michael Washington, 49 yrs. old, Cincinnati Public School and UC graduate.
  - \*Engine 8, "8 Ball Company," Montgomery and Langdon Farm Roads.
  - \*Cincinnati is 72 fire fighters short. A new recruit class is in February. Average age is 41 of Cincinnati fire fighter.
  - \*Initiatives: New Safe House, Educate the elderly on Fall Prevention, Educate parents/guardians on Car Seats for children, Paramedic on all fire trucks, more Public Education.
- 4) City DOTE report: Traffic Calming (Melissa "Mel" McVey)
  - \* 2 Streets cap with greater than 5000 cars per day. She will look up crash data for us.
    - "Bump Out," or "Speed Cushion."
  - \* Separate neighborhood program for smaller residential streets with less than 5000 cars per day, "street hump" program.
  - \*To recommend a street send an email to board@kennedyheights.org.
- **5) Treasurer's Report**: approved. Motion: Jeffrey Weidner, 2<sup>nd</sup>: Mary Ray. Ayes: 100%. Nays: 0.

- 7) Neighborhood Activation Grant (Mary): \$10,000 grant, suggested to be used Sr. Services Coordinator at The Caring Place to pay a portion of the salary. The agency covers the rest. Services are provided to residents of all four neighborhoods served.
  - \*Deadline to apply is December 31.
  - \*Safe and Clean Cincinnati Grant coming in February, 2022. It was suggested this could be used to add a camera and security light to the back of the Annex.
